Making use of all available sources this Exhibition Trail provides the real backbone for the understanding of today's Cairo and the fundamental role of the Nile in the identity of Egypt: a stimulating vision, in print for the first time, spanning three conquering, festive, scholarly and inventive centuries where the animation of grand ceremonies, organised on the occasion of the enthronement of a new sultan or at the beginning of Ramadan, is witnessed. One is, therefore, intrigued and fascinated but not surprised by the monumental character of the countless religious or civic buildings – palaces, mosques, *madrasas*, mausoleums, hospitals, major multifunctional centres, works of art – with which the Mamluk sultans embellished their successive capitals and particularly the town of Cairo.
